

# **Exam Day Policies**

You MUST have the following to get into the Civil P.E. Exam site.

## **Approved Calculator:**

- 1. The P.E. exam administrators limit the types and models of calculator you allowed to bring into the exam room to the following approved calculators:
  - All Casio FX-115 models.
  - Only HP 33s and HP 35s models.
  - All TI-30X and TI-36X models.
- 2. Note: The California Board has different calculator policies for their Special Exams, check the California Board website for more information.

### **Photo Identification:**

- 1. You cannot get into the exam area without an up-to-date, signed, government-issued photo identification (e.g., driver's license, passport).
- 2. Make sure the first and last name on the photo identification matches the name on your Exam Authorization Notice.
- 3. Make sure your photo identification is government-issued! Student ID cards, credit cards with your picture on them, and Costco membership cards are examples of photo identification not acceptable for admittance to the exam.



#### **Exam Authorization Notice:**

- 1. Your Exam Authorization Notice will typically be available for download via your My NCEES account approximately 2 to 3 weeks prior to the exam date.
- 2. Several states will snail-mail Exam Authorization Notices to your physical address check your state's registration page for details.
- 3. Bring the exam Authorization Notice with you the the exam.
- 4. (See page for all state P.E. websites and board information)

## **Do NOT Bring To The Exam Site:**

- 1. Do NOT bring your own pencils, pens, or erasers to the exam; the test administrators will provide pencils and erasers for you to use and keep.
- 2. Do NOT bring your own scratch paper to the exam; the test administrators will provide exam booklets that will be used for scratch paper, you are not allowed to write onto anything except the exam booklet during the test.
- 3. Do NOT bring Straight edges, compasses, protractors, etc.
- 4. Do NOT bring your phone or if you do, leave it in your car.
